1.2 Government Support

Jobseeker

The Australian Government has offered up to an additional \$550 per fortnight to eligible welfare recipients during the time of the COVID-19 crisis as a Coronavirus Supplement. Eligibility criteria has also been adjusted to make more people eligible for it, and has increased the annual income limit for partners so more people in a couple can apply.

Jobkeeper

The Government Jobseeker package is available to companies that report a 30% loss than this time last year in effort to retain employees, keeping people hired even without work. This is a \$1500 fortnightly payment made directly to employers so they can pay their employees. If you have been laid off of work, talk to the ATO about contacting your employer about eligibility for this package.

Economic Support Payment

The Economic Support Payment is a once-off payment of \$750 for everyone receiving any kind of welfare payment, including veteran support payments, in order to assist in preventing a recession. This has already been paid out, but people who aren't eligible for the Coronavirus Supplement will receive another \$750 Economic Support Payment in July
