

WPI owns and manages 122 homes, accommodating more than 270 women and children.

They include a mixture of 1 and 2 bedroom apartments, 1 and 2 bedroom townhouses, and 3 and 4 bedroom houses. We have an additional 9 homes under construction.

Our homes are scattered within apartment blocks or they are free-standing homes in new or existing estates. Located in thriving communities in Melbourne's inner, middle and outer suburbs, these homes cater for the diverse needs of the women and children that we house.

We strive to make sure that the homes we build or acquire blend into their surrounding communities, and enable access to employment, community, support networks, services, transport, schools and other amenities. Access to schools, disability support, community resources, and in some cases, migrant communities, can be critical factors in establishing successful, long-term tenancies.

We manage an addition 146 affordable rental properties on behalf of other organisations that are suitable for low to middle income earners struggling to afford private rents. They are home to around 300 people.

We strive to ensure our homes are secure and energy efficient. We provide additional security where required and access to female tradespeople.
